

Data Protection Policy of ThinPrint GmbH

The ThinPrint GmbH (hereinafter referred to as “ThinPrint”) strongly emphasizes the protection of personal data. This Data Protection Policy therefore applies to all products, services and websites offered by ThinPrint. ThinPrint adheres to any and all applicable data protection provisions, including but not limited to the Federal Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz, BDSG).

Data collected by ThinPrint and Use thereof

If you register with ThinPrint in order to purchase ThinPrint products, download software or book services offered by ThinPrint via its websites, you are obliged to provide and complete personal data and information. **Personal information** include for example name, email-address and the password for the User account. In general, any and all information that allows us to individually identify people. Certain services also require that you provide us with your credit/debit card information or other relevant bank account information. Any such data is encrypted before transmission. After we receive such data, we print them, file them in paper form and store them in a specially secured manner. The electronic data is deleted after the print out. On your first visit to a ThinPrint website, we send a **cookie**, e.g. a small electronic file consisting of a certain character string allowing us to identify your browser. ThinPrint uses cookies to improve its services and websites according to user preferences. You may adjust your browser to reject cookies, but the rejection of cookies might result in the inaccessibility and malfunction of certain services and websites of ThinPrint. Furthermore, ThinPrint’s server automatically records information sent by your browser if you visit a website. Such so-called **log data** include your web request, the IP address, and the type of the browser, the browser language, data and time as well as cookies. These log data allow to clearly identify your browser.

ThinPrint only uses the collected personal data as indicated for the purposes they were actually intended for. Apart from the purposes mentioned above, the purposes include provision of ThinPrint’s services and products for users and the development of new services and products. You can find information on which personal information is collected for which purpose with the respective services and products.

Approval of Collection of Personal Data/Revocation

We request that you, by checking a special box, state your consent to our using your data for a different purpose than originally indicated, should this be necessary. You may, however, refuse to give this prior consent.

Without your express prior consent, ThinPrint will not use your personal information for other purposes than indicated and in connection with the respective services or products and this Data Protection Policy.

You are at all times entitled to refuse to provide personal information or to revoke provided information. Please be aware, though, that in such case ThinPrint might not be able to offer you all available services. If you revoke personal information which is still necessary for processing effective contractual relations between you and ThinPrint, we will delete any personal information promptly after termination of the contractual relations.

Use of the Cortado Services

ThinPrint expressly informs its users of the Cortado Services that documents which are printed while using the Cortado Services are filed on our servers for the actual duration of the printing process. Upon completion of the printing process, such documents are automatically deleted from our servers.

Transfer of Personal Data to Third Parties

Only upon your express prior consent will ThinPrint transfer your personal data to any third parties.

Without your express prior consent, ThinPrint will only transfer or disclose your personal data upon presentation of a search warrant, judicial order, judicial decree or another form of lawful cases regulated by law.

Data Security

ThinPrint uses adequate security measures to prevent unauthorized access or change, transfer or deletion of personal information. Such measures include, but are not limited to internal review of our data collection practices, filings and processing as well as physical and technical measures to prevent access to the systems on which we store such sensitive data.

Access to such data is internally limited to such members of staff who for the operation, development and improvement of our services and products require knowledge of such data. Such members of staff are required to adhere to special confidential requirements. If such members of staff, however, breach the secrecy requirements, they are subject to labor legal consequences and criminal prosecution.

Access to and Updating or Deletion of Personal Data

ThinPrint enables you to access your personal data through the various websites and offers you the possibility to correct, modify or delete such data if necessary and if they are not required for legal means of processing of contractual relations. In the interest of data security, you have to identify yourself with your password before you can modify or delete any personal data .

Enforcement

Alterations and Amendments
