

Data Privacy Statement for the ThinPrint Personal Printing app

The Personal Printing app is a client component of the print solution **ThinPrint Personal Printing**. The Personal Printing app is offered by **ThinPrint GmbH** (hereinafter referred to as "ThinPrint"). The Personal Printing app complies with the data protection requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the German Federal Data Protection Act (German: Bundesdatenschutzgesetz, BDSG) as well as other German and European laws relevant to data protection.

Data used by the Personal Printing server or by the Personal Printing app

User data

The Personal Printing app must be configured for you after installation on your mobile device (smartphone or tablet). For this purpose, you will receive a configuration file from the Personal Printing server as an e-mail attachment. This file contains your user ID, which is saved with the configuration of the app on your mobile device. To do this, the app accesses the file system of your mobile device.

Every time you print with the Personal Printing app, your app sends the user ID to the Personal Printing server to assign your print jobs. The ID can be transmitted via an encrypted or an unencrypted connection. This is determined by the administrator on the Personal Printing server that is located in your company.

A transfer of user data to other companies does not take place.

Data logged by Personal Printing (log data)

The Personal Printing app can create a log file for logging or troubleshooting purposes. However, this function is deactivated by default.

Furthermore, the Personal Printing server automatically records usage data when you use the JobViewer, register or authenticate yourself on a network printer or when the Personal Printing server sends a print job on your request. This so-called log data includes the connection of your browser or app to the personal printing server, your IP address, browser type and language as well as the date and time of a request. If necessary, the administrators of your company can use the log data for troubleshooting or for verification purposes.

Deletion of user data

Your user data will be automatically deleted from the Personal Printing server if your Personal Printing account is deleted by your administrator. On the device, your user data will be deleted from the server if you uninstall the app or if your administrator does so.

Permissions of the ThinPrint Personal Printing app

The app accesses the file system of your mobile device to store your user ID and, if necessary, to write log data. To scan the QR code on the network printer, the app requires access to your mobile device's camera.

Transfer of personal data to third parties

ThinPrint will transfer your personal data (user data) from Personal Printing to any third party only upon your express prior consent. Without your express prior consent, ThinPrint will only transfer or disclose your personal data upon presentation of a search warrant, judicial order, judicial decree or another form of lawful cases regulated by law.

All of the Personal Printing server is in the hands of the IT administration of the ThinPrint customer, i. e. your company.

Data security

ThinPrint uses adequate security measures to prevent unauthorized access or change, transfer or deletion of personal information. Such measures include, but are not limited to, internal review of our data collection practices, filings and processing as well as technical and organizational security measures to prevent access to the systems we use to store such sensitive data.

The management of your user data for the Personal Printing server belongs to the ThinPrint customer, i. e. to the IT administrators of your company.

Access to and updating or deletion of personal data

User data set up by your administrator in your company will be managed by him/her. In this case, please contact your IT administrator or the data protection officer of your company.
